If the Feast falls on Lazarus' Saturday we sing (St. John's Liturgy):

Troparia: Lazarus' Saturday and Annunciation

Kontakia: Glory ... Lazarus' Saturday, both now and ever ..., and the Annunciation

Instead of Svjatij Bože, we sing Jelici (music on page 63)
Prokeimena and Epistles: Annunciation and Lazarus' Saturday

Irmos: Annunciation

Communion verse: Annunciation and Lazarus' Saturday.

If the Feast falls on Palm Sunday we sing (St. John's Liturgy):

Introit: Proclaim from day to day the salvation of our God (*Ps 96:2*).
